CLARE VALLEY SHIRAZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2012

The 2012 Hill 5 is a traditional Australian blend of two premium red varieties Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon sourced from the Clare Valley. The Shiraz portion was sourced from Hill 5 at Sevenhill and the Cabernet from a small vineyard at Watervale.

Small parcels were fermented in open fermenters. A portion of this wine undertook natural ferment. The wine was fermented for 11 days on skins then pressed to new and older French oak barriques. After 20 months of maturation, the wine was bottled in December 2013.

The 2012 Hill 5 Shiraz Cabernet is a vibrant deep cherry red colour. It shows lifted dark fruit, spice, chocolate, and jube aromas on the nose. The palate is rich and full bodied, with great weight and length. Roasted meat and chocolate characters dominate, balanced well with charry, spicy oak and pleasant soft dusty tannins on the finish. This is a elegant wine with nice balance and structure.
