CLARE VALLEY SHIRAZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2013

The 2013 Hill 5 is a traditional Australian blend of two premium red varieties Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon. They are both sourced from a small vineyard Hill 5 at Sevenhill in the heart of the Clare Valley.

Small parcels were fermented in open fermenters. A portion of this wine undertook natural ferment. The wine was fermented for 14 days on skins then pressed to new and older French oak barriques. After 18 months of maturation, the wine was bottled in November 2014.

The 2013 Hill 5 Shiraz Cabernet is a vibrant deep cherry red colour. It shows lifted dark fruit, spice, chocolate, and jupe aromas on the nose. The palate is rich and full bodied, with great weight and length. Roasted meat and chocolate characters dominate, balance well with charry, spicy oak and pleasant soft dusty tannins on the finish. This is a elegant wine with nice balance and structure.
