## THE ALDO

### BAROSSA VALLEY OLD VINE GRENACHE SHIRAZ 2011

Aldo (Stevens's father) has tended to a small vineyard in the Barossa his entire life with great care and consideration to produce the highest fruit quality.

The 2011 Grenache/Shiraz 'The Aldo' was produced from Grenache that Aldo has grown. The vines are about 70 years old and are dry grown. The fruit was hand harvested and crushed into open fermenters with a small parcel going through natural fermentation. After 14 days on skins the wine was basket pressed to older French oak barriques for maturation. At blending, 18% Shiraz was added to give texture, weight and complexity to the palate. We bottle the Aldo early to capture the fresh fruit characters.

The 2011 Aldo Grenache Shiraz is a deep crimson colour. The wine shows lifted dark cherries, raspberry and confection aromas. The palate is big and juicy with a lovely well rounded mouthfeel with excellent intensity and length. The 2011 Aldo is made to be enjoyed young when the fruit is at its peak. The Aldo Grenache Shiraz is our most consistent wine from vintage to vintage, although the percentages of Grenache and Shiraz will change each year. Without a doubt this wine is our favourite to make each year.
